Questions for the T-90 Small Group

Getting Started:

- What are current attitudes of Christians toward homosexuals and vice versa? What are tension points?
- What questions come to mind about the message?

Digging In:

- 1. Read Leviticus 18:1-4; 24-30. In chapter 18, Israel is called to be different than other nations. What does this tell you about the sexual practices of these other nations around them? How does this relate to today?
- 2. Read Leviticus 18:22 for God's opinion on homosexuality. Is this sinful act worse than any other sin?
- 3. Read Hebrews 13:4. What does this say about the boundaries for physical intimacy only in marriage?
- 4. Read 1 Cor. 6:9-10. Does Paul mean that believers who do these things will not enter heaven? Why or why not?
- 5. Read Romans 1:24-32. When mankind did not follow the truth, what did God do to them?
- 6. Has society changed for the better or worse since Paul wrote these?
- 7. Paul explains the root cause for sin is a depraved mind or this sin nature in all of us. How does that differ from modern psychology?
- 8. How does Luke 10:25-37 relate to our treatment of people different than us such as a homosexual?
- 9. According to Mark 12:31 we are to love our neighbor as ourselves. What does this look like with a same sex attracted person? What makes this difficult?

Taking It Home:

- 10. How have Christians neglected to love and help those who are attracted to the same sex? Do you think Christians need to repent for their attitudes and actions?
- 11. Is there certain thinking or attitudes you need to change?
